- a) Proteins.
 - 1) Proteins are important in building up processes.
 - 2) Hormones and enzymes are proteins.

 - 4) Antibodies are formed of proteins.
 - 5) Plasma proteins and haemoglobin act as acid-base balance of blood.
- b) Liver
 - 1) Production of bile.
 - 2) Production uric acid.
